
Jerusalem conquered by Babylon as God prophesied



King Belshazzar gave a great banquet for a thousand of his nobles and drank wine with them




Belshazzar gave orders to bring in the gold and silver goblets from the temple in Jerusalem



and the king and his nobles, his wives and his concubines drank from them




Suddenly the fingers of a human hand appeared and wrote on the plaster of the wall,

The king summoned the enchanters, astrologers and diviners, all the wise men of Babylon.




So Daniel was brought before the king,

Daniel rebuke the King for he was not humble before GOD




Daniel read the writing in the wall and tell the meaning to the King

Mene: God has numbered the days of your reign and brought it to an end.


Tekel: You have weighed on the scales and found wanting (very light)
